The Illinois Stream Mitigation Guidance

In 2010, the St. Louis District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers prepared the new Illinois Stream Mitigation Guidance to address typical impacts and mitigation proposals in the context of processing Section 404 permit applications. The guidance provides definitions for stream types, priority waters and existing condition characteristics. Additionally, stream restoration factors are covered that review the net benefit(s) for restoration. The Guidance provides worksheets to determine adverse impacts and total mitigation credits required, an evaluation of stream restoration to determine total channel restoration/relocation credits generated, and a riparian worksheet to determine credits generated for riparian restoration.

Mr. McMullen will provide an overview of the guidance and go through the worksheets to show how they are properly used to determine impacts, mitigation required, and an evaluation of proposed restoration methods that can be quantified for credit towards mitigation.

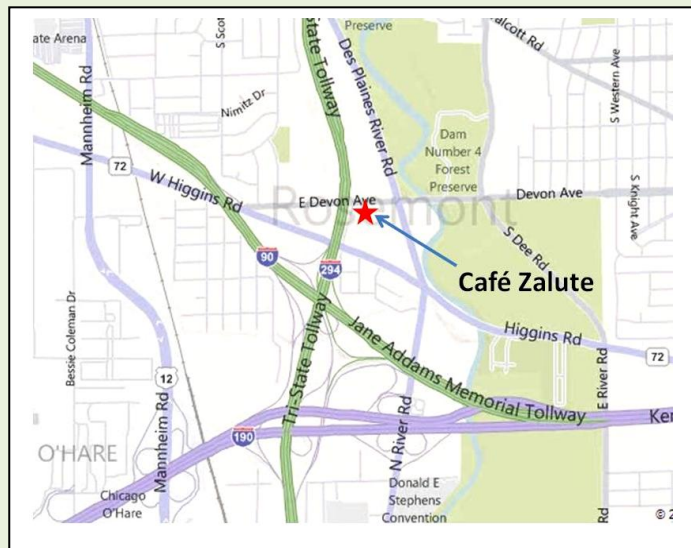
